- A range of outpatient services, bringing hospital experts out into the community.
- On site diagnostic testing, to support the fast local delivery of complete patient pathways.
- Convenient access to minor surgery, within comfortable and dignified surroundings
- Improved facilities for the provision of therapies and rehabilitation
- A 20 bedded inpatient ward, focused on helping patients regain their independence.
