

BRIGHT IDEAS GRANT: SMALL IDEAS - BIG DIFFERENCE

Until March 18th Department of Health are making available a Bright Ideas Grant. This is a new £50K grant which is about finding bright ideas about dignity in care and helping people put them into practice.

Dignity champions, staff and members of the public are being asked to submit their Bright Ideas online and bid for a share of the Bright Ideas Grant. Dignity champions and members of the public then have the opportunity to vote on which ideas receive funding and offer their advice, support and ideas.

If you have a Bright Idea but it is not yet fully developed you are also able to request a helping hand when submitting your idea. For example you may need a local council or care home to work with you to implement your idea and they will be able to get in contact with you to take the idea forward.

Make your bid for a share of the Bright Ideas Grant today. The longer your idea appears on the BIG website the more likely it is to receive more votes and receive funding.
