

Guidance for voluntary groups from NCVO

As the end of one funding year approaches and a new one begins, voluntary and community organisations are understandably nervous about possible changes to the funding they get from public bodies.

Organisations have already been approaching us with real issues and concerns that they have, and in many cases we are advocating on behalf of them to try to ensure good partnership working from local authorities and councils based on Compact principles.
